## NUCLEAR MEDICINE/PET

Division of Nuclear Medicine/PET (Positron Emission Tomography) at Children's Hospital Boston is one of the oldest and largest programs of its kind in the country that is completely dedicated to children. Using radiopharmaceuticals, Children's specialists can evaluate metabolic, physiologic and pathologic conditions of the body for the purposes of diagnosis, therapy and research. For more than 35 years, the division has been a nationally recognized leader in the field of pediatric nuclear medicine.

More than 7,000 nuclear medicine procedures are performed here every year utilizing the full range of nuclear medicine technologies, in a safe, comfortable and child-friendly atmosphere.
